War Veteran Dies of Self Inflicted Wound

Argonne Soldier, Gassed and in Poor Health, Ends Life With Bullet.

James Adcock, 23 years old, who, in the presence of his wife, shot himself above the heart at 7 o'clock Monday night, died at 8:17 o'clock last night at City Hospital. The bullet pierced a lung.

After having been gassed in France, in July, 1918, Adcock had been in poor health. It is believed this prompted his act. Desides his widow, Mrs. Rosie Ad-

cock, he is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. John Adcock.
