Vaura Jones' Murderer Will Have to Answer to the Higher Court.

The remains of Peter Yates, the patriarchal murderer of Laura Jones, who died in the City Hospital Thursday last, were prepared for burial by Gran W. Smith. Yates had given the name of Sam Forman, of Campbell and Adams streets, as his next friend, and he took charge of the body.

The remains were buried yesterday afternoon at 4 o'clock in the Bastern cemetery. No members of the immediate family, who lived in Hardin county, were present, but certain of Yates' friends attended the last sad rites of the man who had committed a cold-blooded murder, and then brooded over it until he died, after three un-Buccessful attempts at suicide.
